

MMG Fellowship for Summer Research in Israel



This annual Fellowship in memory of Melvin Morris Goldberg sends one undergraduate engineering student from any U.S. University to visit Israel in the summer to perform supervised technical research. The \$3000.00 Fellowship is presented to a junior or senior who demonstrates the enthusiasm, aptitude, and the motivation to arrange a personalized research program. The Fellowship is intended to provide partial support for travel and living costs.

Candidates should work with faculty at their primary university to develop a research proposal and confirm a willing supervisor at one of Israel's universities or research centers (eg, Bar-Ilan, Ben-Gurion, Haifa U., Hebrew U., Technion, Tel-Aviv U., the Weizmann Institute).

Applications are due March 1 of each year.
